**MR D LAST** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise as of 1 July 2020 the number of sworn police officers deployed in frontline roles in (a) the Far Northern Police Region, (b) the Northern Police Region, (c) the Central Police Region, (d) the North Coast Police Region, (e) the North Brisbane Police District, (f) the South Brisbane Police District, (g) the South Eastern Police Region and (h) the Southern Police Region?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the organisation is in the process of a significant realignment, including the establishment of the Far Northern Police Region and the North Coast Police Region during 2021 as part of the Service Alignment Program. Therefore, the QPS has advised that the number of police officers deployed in these regions will be determined upon finalisation of the realignment.

However, I appreciate the Member's interest in this matter and can advise that information on Queensland's approved police strengths can be found in my response to Question on Notice 767 of 2020.
