

## **Question on Notice**

**MR D LAST** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH) –

### **QUESTION**

Will the Minister advise when the repairs to the areas of the Moranbah Hospital damaged by termites will be completed?

### **ANSWER**

I am advised that the Mackay HHS has engaged a contractor to undertake rectification works to inpatient rooms 9, 10 and 11, and the patient lounge. The contractor commenced work on 24 May 2021, and I am advised that these areas have been completed.

I am further advised that the permanent repairs to the morgue are currently being undertaken and are expected to be completed by the end of June 2021.

Mackay HHS has completed thermal imaging of Moranbah Hospital to assist in identifying any other affected areas. The first two rows of concrete pavers along the affected side of the hospital have also been lifted to proactively treat for termites and assessed for any entry points.
