**MR D LAST** ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise when the teaching vacancies at the Dysart State High School and the Moranbah State High School will be filled?

ANSWER:

The Palaszczuk Government continues to invest in its teaching workforce and implements a number of initiatives to attract and retain high quality teachers.

As part of the commitments the Government took to the last election, we are employing 6190 new teachers over the next four years.

In relation to the specific vacancies referred to, it has been confirmed that there are currently no vacant positions at Dysart State High School and Moranbah State High School has recently completed recruitment activities to permanently fill two teaching roles.
